This Patent Quality Week, from June 6 - 10, we are setting out to demystify the system and explore what it means and why that matters—for us and our policymakers.

Everyone in the country—from small innovators and large technology-oriented companies, to manufacturers, financial services providers, main street businesses, cancer patients, and customers looking to buy the latest tech—has a vital stake in the patent system.
